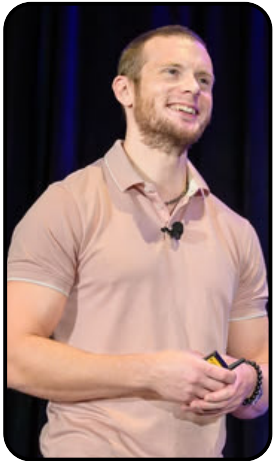




THE JUNE SUMMIT
